The district would comprise approximately 226,369 acres consisting of Residential (379 parcels/160 acres); Commercial (78 parcels/354 acres); Industrial (33 parcels/3,314 acres); Agricultural/mining/oil & gas use (1,884 parcels/197,225 acres; Other Uses 796 parcels/ 25,286 acres).
